Come join us for a great meal and a time to hear how the TAG consulting process is going. We are excited to share the wonderful progress that is being made through this planning process.

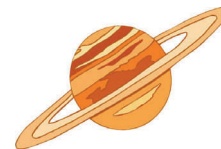
